The Hospital's qualifications for charity care are as 1) Charity care is limited to medically necessary services. Patients receiving certain elective services, such as those considered cosmetic, investigational or nental, are expected to make payment arrangements in advance, as these types of services are not covered by the charity care program 2) Patient's family must be at or below 300% of the current Federal Poverty Income Guidelines for their applicable family size. The Hospital maintains records to identify and in the level of charity care it provides. The difference between the standard rates (or the discounted rates if negotiated or eligible) and the amounts actually collected after all reasonable collection efforts have been exhausted is charged against the allowance for doubtful accounts. During 2015, the Hospital increased its estimate from \$4,769,579 to \$5,266,350 in the allowance for doubtful accounts relating to self-pay patients and during 2014 the Hospital increased its estimate from \$4,050,526 to \$4,769,579 in the allowanc
