IN 2012, A COMPENSATION SPECIALIST WITH A NATIONAL ACCOUNTING FIRM WAS BNOAGED BY THE NABC TO SPECIFICALLY PROVIDE ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE TO NABC'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS IN CONNECTION WITH THE NEGOTIATION OF A NEW COMPENSATION PLAN AND EMPLOY MENT AGREEMENT FOR NABC'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR THE COMPENSATION OF A NEW COMPENSATION PLAN AND EMPLOY MENT AGREEMENT ENTAILED AN UPDATE OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS NEW COMPENSATION PLAN AND EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT ENTAILED AN UPDATE OF THE COMPETITIVE COMPENSATION ANALYSIS FOR THE POSITION PERFORMED PREVIOUSLY FOR THE NABC.
