TOTAL REVENUE WAS REDUCED, AND TOTAL EXPENSES WERE REDUCED BY THE SAME AMOUNT. SPECIFICALLY, PART VIII, LINE 2A TOURNAMENT INCOME DECREASED FROM \$1,586,550 TO \$1,173,054. PART VIII, LINE 2B ARCHERY CENTER INCOME DECREASED FROM \$47,360 TO \$43,817. PART IX, LINE 24A TOURNAMENT COSTS DECREASED FROM \$1,434,415 TO \$1,020,919. PART IX, LINE 24E ARCHERY PROGRAM EXPENSES DECREASED FROM \$4,595 TO \$1,052.

THE APPROPRIATE ADJUSTMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE WITHIN THE INTERNAL ACCOUNTING SYSTEM TO RELFECT THESE REDUCTIONS. THE ABOVE CHANGES RESULTED IN NO CHANGE IN NET ASSETS OR FUND BALANCES.
