Child Care Choices also contacts parents of children periodically to verify that their children were in child care with the providers who are on the program. If any providers' records are incomplete, or if a child cannot be verified to have been in a provider's care, then Child Care Choices, Inc. is required to reduce the amount paid on a current meal claim or recover the amount from a previous meal claim. Line 2: Child Care Choices, Inc. provides child care financial assistance to low income familes. These funds are provided by the United Way of Central Minnesota. The funds are to pay for a portion of a family's child care expenses not covered by the state child care assistance program.
