Organizing and Supporting Training Opportunities: In FY 2015, the Mid-Atlantic Regional Air Management Association, Inc. (MARAMA) helped member agencies develop and retain effective staff members by organizing and supporting technical training opportunities to help member agency staff understand pollution control requirements and monitoring methods. MARAMA organized 10 in-person training courses including Basic Inspector Training, Stack Testing, Enforcement Case Development & Resolution, two courses on NOx Emissions, NSR/PSD, Ambient Monitoring, Air Pollution Control Devices, Regional Haze SIP Training, and Permitting Practices & Principles. Additionally, MARAMA organized 6 meetings and workshops including an Asbestos coordination meeting, a coordination meeting on Fumigation, an Air Quality and Health Workshop, MARAMA's Science Workshop, and a Monitoring Committee Workshop. MARAMA organized and presented 18 on-line webinars with over 1,000 participants The webinars covered topics including: AERMOD for Non-Modelers, On-line Tools for Monitoring Network Assessments, Introduction to Air Pollution Emission Inventory Preparation, Predicting Air & Health Impacts of Construction, Mobile Emissions True-Up, Clean Air Strategy for NY and NJ, SQL Basics for EMF Users, and EMF Growth and Control. 48 MARAMA members also attended 12 national and regional conferences and meetings with support from MARAMA.

Improving and Updating the Regional Emissions Inventory: To help member agencies work together and collaborate with nearby states, the Mid-Atlantic Regional Air Management Association, Inc. (MARAMA) prepared a regional inventory of air pollutant emissions for use in air quality modeling. MARAMA continued to work with state and local agencies and the US Environmental Protection Agency to update the regional

future years of 2018 and 2028. MARAMA facilitated use of the cloud-based Emissions Modeling Framework (EMF) to house the emissions inventory, identify and correct issues with the data, create specific files for special projects, apply growth and control factors, and transmit data to regional modeling centers. MARAMA organized frequent conference calls and webinars to coordinate preparation of the inventory, provide training on the use of the EMF, and provide organized feedback to EPA on issues related to emissions. MARAMA continued to focus on improving data for Electricity Generating Units (EGUs), on-road mobile sources, and oil and gas operations. MARAMA also helped members utilize the best available emissions inventory data for special projects. MARAMA established a contract with the University of North Carolina to add capability to the EMF cloud-based system so that MARAMA would be able to process data for on-road mobile sources using EPA's MOVES and SMOKE-MOVES modeling systems. MARAMA established a contract with CSRA to help prepare a Technical Support Document for the regional emissions inventory. MARAMA participated in EPA's national Emissions Inventory Conference, helping to provide training and presenting a paper on the ERTAC-EGU emissions forecasting tool, and MARAMA participated on several national work groups to improve the state-of-the-art for emissions inventories.
