Detailed minutes of the meetings of the Compensation Committee are kept and approved at the next meeting of the Committee, setting forth the deliberations and decisions regarding executive compensation.
Part I, Line 4b	Select members of management participate in a Pension Restoration Plan. This plan provides a benefit equal to the normal retirement benefit that would be payable to the participant were it not for the Qualified plan's legislative restrictions on compensation and payable benefits, less the actual benefits under the Qualified plan.
