Upshur County WV is the primary service area for St. Joseph's Hospital.

The 2010 census showed that 19.3% of the population in Upshur county to be below poverty level. Thus, 19.3% of the bad debt cost was used to calculate the estimated amount of the Organization's bad debt expense attributable to patients under the Organization's financial assistance policy.

The Medicare allowable costs and revenues were derived from the Medicare cost report.

Prior to an account going to collections, especially if it is a self-pay patient, the Organization checks Medicaid and charity eligibility. St.

Joseph's hospital requires all self-pay patients to talk to a financial counselor to determine qualification for charity care and Medicaid programs. Self-pay patients are required to show proof that they have been denied by Medicaid. After it is determined that self-pay patients do not qualify for assistance, and if they are still unable to pay their bills,

they are set up on a payment plan suited to their income level. Only when a self-pay patient falls behind on his/her payments and it is certain he or she does not qualify for assistance are they sent to a collection agency.

St. Joseph's Hospital has contracted with an outside company to perform the community wide needs assessment survey and has translated this information into the Community Health Needs Assessment Report which outlines actions taken. In addition, an outside company performs post admission surveys for all inpatients. This survey includes questions regarding whether the patient's needs were met during the stay, and the hospital reviews this HCAHPS data to determine what services may need to be added based on that data.

St. Joseph's Hospital is located in a small town in a rural, mountainous region of West Virginia. The hospital serves its home county (with a population of approximately 24,477 residents), as well as parts of five surrounding counties. The population served is an aging population with nearly 30% of the population in the 45 to 65 year old age group and will be reaching retirement age over the next 20 years, resulting in a major impact on health care in the area. In St. Joseph's Hospital's home county, 18.8% of the population is below the poverty level and nineteen percent (19%) of the population is uninsured, with 4.6% of the children in the county having no insurance. The teen pregnancy rate is 31.2%. The following hospitals provide a full range of acute care, ancillary and case management services and many also provide long-term care. The hospitals

are located in the immediate service area or the contiguous service area:

Stonewall Jackson Memorial Hospital, United Hospital Center, Davis

Memorial Hospital, Louis A. Johnson VA Medical Center, and Broaddus

Hospital. In addition, William J. Sharpe Hospital in Weston, West Virginia provides comprehensive psychiatric services for patients that have been involuntarily committed to the facility.

St. Joseph's hospital promotes the health of the community by maintaining an open medical staff, using community members on its board of directors, providing support of community health activities (blood screenings, health fair, flu shot clinics, etc.). The Hospital has also been actively recruiting both primary care providers and specialists to meet the health care needs of our service area.

St. Joseph's Hospital of Buckhannon, Inc. is a not-for-profit health care facility wholly sponsored by Pallottine Health Services, Inc. (PHS).

Pallottine Health Services is a ministry of the Pallottine Missionary
