IN THE ABSENCE OF SUCH A DETERMINATION, SUCH INSTRUMENTS SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE TREASURER AND COUNTERSIGNED BY THE PRESIDENT AND CEO.

ALL FUNDS OF THE FOUNDATION SHALL BE DEPOSITED AND/OR INVESTED TO THE CREDIT OF THE FOUNDATION IN FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS SELECTED BY THE BOARD. THE BOARD MAY ACCEPT ON BEHALF OF THE FOUNDATION ANY CONTRIBUTIONS, GIFTS, BEQUEST OR DEVISE FOR GENERAL OR FOR SPECIAL PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION, AND MAY ACCEPT IN KIND PERSONAL SERVICE IN ITS DISCRETION.

THE BOARD MAY ELECT OR APPOINT ANY PERSON OR PERSONS TO ACT IN AN ADVISORY CAPACITY TO THE FOUNDATION.

THE BOARD SHALL REVIEW AND EITHER APPROVE OR MODIFY AND APPROVE THE FOUNDATION'S ANNUAL BUDGET PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH IT APPLIES.
