Part I, Line 2	Energy Outreach Colorado (EOC) distributes funds to a network of agencies around the state for utility bill payment assistance. Each agency is charged with using the funds specifically for heating or heating related utilities. The funds are not given to individual clients but directly to the utility vendor in question, in addition, EOC maintains an on-line database where agencies must enter client data immediately when the client receives assistance. This database collects details of clients' name, address, demographic information, income data, housing data, and utility vendor information. The program manager checks on a regular basis to see that funding is being distributed to the relevant vendors. Each client may only receive assistance once during a grant year (November 1 through October 31), should two agencies pay for the same client in a grant year then one of the payments is disallowed and the agency must pay for the bill with other than EOC's grant funds.
