The 10/31/15 balance sheet includes a Note Payable of \$216,236 to the Association's wholly-owned subsidiary. The funds were borrowed to provide financing for the Association's move to new office space - construction costs of tenant leasehold improvements, purchase of new furniture and equipment, etc. A promissory note was drawn effective 10/31/14, with a repayment schedule of over 7 years at the Applicable Federal Rate of interest. Total Revenue and Expenses do not reflect the unrealized losses

on securities of \$(20,152).

- Part V line 2(d) The Association receives royalties from its subsidiary (ASC), in accordance with written agreement based on use of its trade name and identifying logo.
- Part V line 2(d) The Association moved into new office space in September, 2014.

 To help finance the costs of tenant improvements and purchase of new furniture and equipment, ASC loaned the Association \$250,000. (See Sch O for details on the promissory note.) During the fiscal year ended 10/31/15, the Association made loan payments to ASC totalling \$38,104 [Principal-\$33,764; Interest-\$4,340]
- Part V line 2(d) The Association charges ASC a management fee, which is in accordance with a written agreement and is based on employees' time records which reflect their time spent on behalf of the subsidiary. The management fee includes an allocation of occupancy costs and overhead, based on the percentages of employees' time attributable to ASC's activities. PIIAC collects fees from the subsidiary for advertising in the Association's publication (Colorado Insurance News). The fees are analogous to the rates paid by other advertisers in the publication.
- Part V line 2(d) Some of the activities of the Association, e.g. the Annual Dinner, Leadership Conference, and certain education classes, are supported by various corporate sponsors including ASC.
