SEK-CAP performs a wage comparability study annually to ensure the salary and wage structure is similar to other organizations of like size and employee base in our area

SEK-CAP adheres to the executive level salary cap that prohibits the use of federal funds to pay any portion of compensation to an above Executive Level II, which is \$183,300 effective January 2015. Compensation is defined to Include salary, bonus, leave, and benefits
