The difference between the standard rates (or discounted rates if negotiated or eligible) and the amounts actually collected after all reasonable collection efforts have been exhausted is charged against the allowance for doubtful accounts During 2015, the Retreat decreased its estimate from \$2,804,605 to \$2,256,447 in the allowance for doubtful accounts relating to self-pay patients. Such changes resulted from trends experienced in the collection of amounts from patients for which they are financially responsible and from fluctuations
