

GENERAL GRANT TERMS, CONDITIONS AND UNDERSTANDINGS
FOR EXPENDITURE RESPONSIBILITY

TTEE U/W OF HERBERT A CHASE

In addition to the specific terms and conditions in the grant distribution letter dated January 5, 2016, to which these General Terms, Conditions and Understandings are attached, Bank of America as Trustee of the TTEE U/W OF HERBERT A CHASE is making distributions to you as the trust beneficiary contingent upon the following:

Expenditure Responsibility:

Distributions to your organization from the Trust are "expenditure responsibility" grants within the meaning of section 4945(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 ("Code").
