WE STARTED OUT AS GRASSROOTS ADVOCATES, BRINGING TOGETHER RESIDENTS, GOVERNMENT, AND LOCAL SUPPORTERS TO TRANSFORM AN ABANDONED WATERFRONT INTO A WORLD-CLASS PUBLIC PARK. THE CONSERVANCY'S CENTER PROVIDES MULTIPLE INTERACTIVE ELEMENTS INCLUDING AN EAST RIVER AQUARIUM, A DISCOVERY STATION WITH A 10' SCALE MODEL OF THE PARK, AND MORE THAT OFFER AN IN-DEPTH LOOK AT THE PARK'S ECOLOGY, HISTORY, AND SUSTAINABLE DESIGN.
