Develop social change campaigns specific to this issue. We also are committed to developing new models of collaboration and partnership. Like all effective movements for social change, ours requires close and creative collaboration across the various roles in our movement and across the many disciplines that contribute to our understanding of child sexual abuse. By bringing the diverse parts of our movement together around a common vision, the Just Beginnings Collaborative is building the critical mass that will propel our movement forward.
