THROUGH TGTL, STORYCORPS INVITED HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM ACROSS THE NATION TO USE OUR NEW STORYCORPS MOBILE APP TO RECORD AND PRESERVE STORIES WITH A GRANDPARENT OR ELDER OVER THANKSGIVING WEEKEND. AS PART OF THIS INITIATIVE, STORYCORPS ALSO CREATED A FREE, ONLINE TEACHER TOOLKIT TO HELP TEACHERS INTEGRATE TGTL INTO EXISTING SOCIAL STUDIES CURRICULA. STORYCORPSU: STORYCORPSU IS AN INTERACTIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM THAT USES STORYCORPS CONTENT AND METHODS TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF IDENTITY AND SOCIAL INTELLIGENCE IN STUDENTS AT HIGH SCHOOLS ACROSS THE COUNTRY. THE GOALS OF STORYCORPSU ARE TO: (1) INCREASE STUDENTS' SPEAKING AND LISTENING SKILLS; (2) ENHANCE STUDENTS' SELF- AND SOCIAL-AWARENESS, A KEY INDICATOR OF SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING; (3) STRENGTHEN SCHOOL CONNECTEDNESS, A STRONG FACTOR IN STUDENT RETENTION AND ACADEMIC SUCCESS; AND (4) SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF STUDENTS' IDENTITY AND SOCIAL INTELLIGENCE.
