such that they are attending university-level classes in Managua. The students have done very well c	ompeting with other schools in
academics and sports, and have been invited to participate at the National level in several programs.	
PC-A continues to offer academic selections not available for the public school counterparts, including	g English, religion, computer science,
music, art, and traditional folkloric dance and studies. Several graduates of the 2015 class have becomes	me eligible to pursue their studies
at the university level if they can obtain funding to do so.	
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
