ALL RECIPIENTS WILL BE 501(C)(3) TAX EXEMPT ENTITIES AND THERE WILL BE NO RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RECIPIENTS AND THE FOUNDATION. THE FOUNDATION WILL REQUIRE ALL CHARITIES TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE GRANTS AND GIVE AN ANNUAL REPORT AS TO THE USE OF THE FUNDS AND THE STATUS OF ANY ON-GOING PROJECTS. IF NECESSARY, THE FOUNDATION WILL REQUIRE UPDATED BUDGET INFORMATION OR ADDITIONAL REPORTS TO ENSURE THE FUNDS ARE BEING USED PROPERLY.
