EFFECTIVE JUNE 10, 2009, THE FOUNDATION ADOPTED THE UNIFORM PRUDENT MANAGEMENT OF INSTITUTIONAL FUNDS ACT OF 2006 ("UPMIFA").

THE FOUNDATION'S ENDOWMENT CONSISTS OF TWELVE DONOR PERMANENTLY RESTRICTED INDIVIDUAL FUNDS ESTABLISHED FOR A VARIETY OF PURPOSES. AS REQUIRED BY GENERALLY ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES ("GAAP"), NET ASSETS ASSOCIATED WITH ENDOWMENT FUNDS, ARE CLASSIFIED AND REPORTED BASED ON THE EXISTENCE OF DONOR-IMPOSED RESTRICTIONS. THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FOUNDATION HAS INTERPRETED THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY'S ENACTED VERSION OF THE UPMIFA AS REQUIRING THE PRESERVATION OF THE HISTORIC DOLLAR VALUE OF DONOR-RESTRICTED ENDOWMENT FUNDS (ABSENT EXPLICIT DONOR STIPULATIONS TO THE CONTRARY). AS A RESULT OF THIS INTERPRETATION, THE FOUNDATION CLASSIFIES AS PERMANENTLY RESTRICTED NET ASSETS (A) THE ORIGINAL VALUE OF GIFTS DONATED TO THE PERMANENTLY RESTRICTED NET ASSETS (B) THE ORIGINAL VALUE OF SUBSEQUENT GIFTS TO THE PERMANENT ENDOWMENT (C) THE NET REALIZABLE VALUE OF FUTURE PAYMENTS TO PERMANENTLY RESTRICTED NET ASSETS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DONOR'S GIFT INSTRUMENT (OUTSTANDING ENDOWMENT PLEDGES NET OF APPLICABLE DISCOUNT) AND (D) APPRECIATION (DEPRECIATION), GAINS (LOSSES) AND INCOME EARNED ON THE FUND WHEN THE DONOR STATES THAT

SUCH INCREASES OR DECREASES ARE TO BE TREATED AS CHANGES IN PERMANENTLY RESTRICTED NET ASSETS.

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FURTHER UNDERSTANDS THAT EXPENDITURE FROM A DONOR-RESTRICTED FUND IS LIMITED TO THE USES AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE ENDOWMENT FUND IS ESTABLISHED AND THE USE OF NET APPRECIATION, REALIZED GAINS (WITH RESPECT TO ALL ASSETS) AND UNREALIZED GAINS (WITH RESPECT ONLY TO READILY MARKETABLE ASSETS) IS LIMITED TO THE EXTENT THAT THE FAIR VALUE OF A DONOR-RESTRICTED FUND EXCEEDS THE HISTORIC DOLLAR VALUE OF THE FUND (UNLESS THE APPLICABLE GIFT INSTRUMENT INDICATES THAT NET APPRECIATION SHALL NOT BE EXPENDED), TO THE EXTENT THAT SUCH EXPENDITURE IS PRUDENT, CONSIDERING THE LONG AND SHORT TERM NEEDS OF THE FOUNDATION IN CARRYING OUT ITS PURPOSES, ITS PRESENT AND ANTICIPATED FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS, EXPECTED TOTAL RETURN ON ITS INVESTMENTS, PRICE LEVEL TRENDS AND GENERAL ECONOMIC CONDITIONS.

THE FOUNDATION INTENDS TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM 2015 EARNINGS IN 2016. A SUGGESTED 4% DRAWDOWN, BASED ON A TWELVE QUARTER ROLLING AVERAGE, WAS APPROVED BY THE SYSTEM'S INVESTMENT COMMITTEE.

THE RELIGIOUS MINISTRIES ENDOWMENT IS ADMINISTERED SUBJECT TO THE FUND AGREEMENT APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RELIGIOUS MINISTRIES ON OCTOBER 25, 2010. THIS AGREEMENT AUTHORIZES A SPENDING RATE OF UP TO 5% PER ANNUM TO BE APPLIED TO THE MINISTRIES' ANNUAL OPERATING EXPENSES.

THE FOUNDATION'S ENDOWMENT SPENDING POLICIES ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE DONORS' GIFT AGREEMENT'S OBJECTIVES TO UTILIZE INCOME TO SUPPORT

MISSION-CRITICAL PROGRAMS WHILE ENSURING THE PRESERVATION OF CAPITAL AND LONG-TERM ENDOWMENT GROWTH.

THE FOUNDATION'S ENDOWMENT INVESTMENTS FALL UNDER THE INVESTMENT POLICY
GUIDELINES AS ESTABLISHED, AND REVIEWED ANNUALLY, BY THE SYSTEM'S
INVESTMENT COMMITTEE.
