Applications should be made in writing to the Foundation affice at any time during the year. Meetings with Foundation staff and/or site visits may be scheduled. Consideration by the board will take place at the earliest possible board meeting. Grants are not awarded to individuals and are generally restricted to projects serving the greater Weshington, O.C. area.

There is no required application form, however, the outline below indicates necessary information and a suggested format.

- 7. Most recent audited financial statement
- Any additional information or materials which would be helpful in evaluating the request.
