



DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR, 2014, HALL ART FOUNDATION CONTINUED TO DEVELOP EXHIBITS OF WORKS OF FINE ART TO DISPLAY ARTISTIC PIECES FOR THE ENJOYMENT AND EDUCATION OF THE PUBLIC. IN ADDITION, THE FOUNDATION COLLABORATES WITH OTHER PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS FROM AROUND THE WORLD TO FACILITATE LOANS FROM ITS COLLECTION AND THE COLLECTIONS OF OTHERS. AS PART OF ITS EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES, THE FOUNDATION HAS PUBLISHED, CO-PUBLISHED AND/OR PROVIDED SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR THE PUBLICATION OF ABOUT A DOZEN BOOKS RELATING TO THE EXHIBITIONS IT HAS ORGANIZED AND CO-ORGANIZED.

DURING THE CURRENT YEAR, 2015, THE HALL ART FOUNDATION HAS CONTINUED AN EXHIBITION PARTNERSHIP WITH THE MASSACHUSETTS OF MUSEUM OF CONTEMPORARY ART (MASS MOCA) IN NORTH ADAMS, MASSACHUSETTS TO PRESENT LONG-TERM INSTALLATIONS OF ARTWORK FROM THE HALL ART FOUNDATION'S COLLECTION AND THE COLLECTIONS OF OTHERS. THESE INSTALLATIONS ARE HELD IN A BUILDING ON THE MASS MOCA CAMPUS SPECIFICALLY REPURPOSED BY THE HALL ART FOUNDATION KNOWN AS BUILDING 15 AS WELL AS ON THE SURROUNDING LAND, LANDSCAPED BY THE FOUNDATION, ONTO WHICH OUTDOOR SCULPTURE IS INSTALLED. (THIS AREA WAS PREVIOUSLY KNOWN AS BUILDING 16 AND INCLUDES CERTAIN OTHER AREAS IN THE VICINITY OF BUILDING 15.) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF CONTRIBUTIONS DURING 2015 TO MASS MOCA WAS \$73,108.

ALSO DURING 2015, THE FOUNDATION ALSO CONTINUED ITS SUPPORT OF THE ASHMOLEAN MUSEUM OF ART AND ARCHAEOLOGY IN OXFORD ENGLAND CONTRIBUTING A TOTAL OF \$268,913 DURING THE YEAR TO SUPPORT THE ARTISTIC EXHIBITIONS OFFERED AT NO COST TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

DURING 2015, THE HALL ART FOUNDATION MAINTAINED ITS OWN EXHIBITION SPACE IN READING VERMONT FOR THE EXHIBITION OF ARTWORKS TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC FREE OF CHARGE. THE TOTAL OF DIRECT EXPENSES MADE TO THE VERMONT LOCATION BY HALL ART FOUNDATION DURING 2015 WAS \$255,912.

#### FEDERAL FOOTNOTES

LAST YEAR, THE HALL ART FOUNDATION ENTERED INTO A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE SCHLOSS DERNEBURG MUSEUM GGMBH (A GERMAN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION AIMING TO SUPPORT ART AND CULTURE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC) TO DEVELOP EXHIBITIONS AT SCHLOSS DERNEBURG IN DERNEBURG, GERMANY OF WORKS OF ART FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND TO ENGAGE IN OTHER PROJECTS TO PROMOTE ART. THE FOUNDATION CONTRIBUTED \$4,836,931 DURING 2015 TO ENHANCE AND EXPAND THE MUSEUM'S ABILITY FOR PUBLIC DISPLAY OF ART.

THE FOUNDATION MAINTAINS ITS ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE AT 521 WEST 23RD STREET IN NEW YORK CITY. A TOTAL OF \$206,498 OF GENERAL EXPENSES THAT INCLUDED THIS OFFICE AS WELL AS OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES WAS SPENT DURING 2015. THE FOUNDATION ALSO PAID FEES OF \$415,262 TO INDEPENDENT ART CONSULTANTS, INCURRED ART STORAGE AND PRESERVATION FEES OF \$206,465 AND INCURRED LEGAL FEES OF \$63,006 TO FURTHER ITS EXEMPT PURPOSE.
