Services include outpatient therapy and home care in St Elizabeth Parish. In 2015, the FORU staff completed a total of 1,253 patient visits at Vincent Strambi Health Center and 64 home visits throughout St. Elizabeth Parish. In November/December 2015, the FORU therapy team hosted three PT students from Arcadia University for a five week clinical internship. In 2015, FORU ran five stroke camps in February, March, May, September and December. The camps consisted of five full days of intensive neurological rehabilitation as patients worked to improve their balance, gait and arm/hand function. Pre/post testing was completed on the first and last day of camp to measure functional changes in these areas. One hundred US/Jamaican volunteer physical therapists and physical therapy students from six different universities participated in the camps. A total of 41 patients were served, all of which made dramatic gains in their functional mobility. FORU also hosted thirteen other US volunteers throughout the year to assist with our ongoing programs. This volunteer program serves to further our exempt purposes by supporting charitable medical services to under-served populations and by providing opportunities for volunteers to be involved in improving the quality of life for those living in under-served areas. Our objective of improving the quality of life of the people we serve was met by improving their functional mobility and helping them to become more independent with their activities of daily living. Our long term goal is to reduce the incidence of stroke in Jamaica through raising awareness and providing health education to the public. In the future, we also hope to provide more comprehensive rehabilitation services including speech and occupational therapy as well as nutrition education and counseling
