Education in India has become commercial. Compassion and a human touch in schools are disappearing. Fees are sky-rocketing. For a poor man, it is a huge task to make his child or children go to school. Though schools appear to be strict and rigid, emphasis on developing character and behavior of the students is rarely found. At Aletheia, where the standard of education is on par with many highly placed schools, we do not resort to harsh practices.

This year there were 461 students, an increase of 30 over last year. The children come from more than 35 villages. Because of drought in the region, more than fifty students dropped out this year. It was a BIG loss to the school to lose those students. The children range from lower kindergarten through 9th grade. Ninth grade was added this year. They are taught in English by 16 teachers and are supported by a principal, an administrator and 10 staff who assist the school in the kitchen, on campus and in the classrooms.

As Aletheia aims to educate more females, we made a slight increase in the girls vs. boys ratio. When the school started in 2009, there were only 64 girls in the school. In 2012, there were 118 (33% of the student body). In 2013, there were 133 female students (36% of the student body). In 2014, there were 161 girls (37.35% of the total student body). This year, we had 178 female students which is makes 38.6% of the total student body. The number of young women served by Aletheia continues to rise. The literacy rate for Banjara women is only 3%. Aletheia is very proud to see this growth. Our goal is to achieve a 55-45 ratio with boys in the student body.

Aletheia is dedicated to imparting a high standard of education even to the students from very poor, rural and illiterate backgrounds. Compassion and individual care towards the poverty-stricken and physically/mentally challenged are exhibited

behavior and manners of students. Aletheia's aim is to develop students in a holistic way by meeting their mental, physical, social, emotional and spiritual needs. One such example is Suhsheela Vidthiya.

Susheela is from a poverty-stricken family which could not afford her education. But Aletheia, with the support from donors, worked wonders in transforming the life of Susheela Vadthiya. She studied in a public/government school, where the standard of education was very poor. She did not even learn the English alphabet properly. Her parents worked as laborers making bricks to earn meager money to look after their four children (three girls and a boy, Susheela being the second child). Many times Susheela had to skip school to work along with her parents to earn a little extra money to sustain the family. They attend a church shepherded by a GBBM pastor. Susheela's elder sister was married before attaining 15 years of age. Child marriage is very common in the Banjara Community. Their financial condition was so poor that they were unable to support Susheela's education in a private school. No doubt, Susheela would have had to discontinue her studies and join her parents in brick making work. Well, she would have been a laborer, except for the kindness and generosity of Ms. Kirk.

Ms. Kirk, a sponsor from the U.S., desired to support a girl financially to go to school and to help a girl not to be married at a very young age. She approached GBBMI to identify a girl child to study at Aletheia. Among many children, Susheela was selected. As her overall knowledge acquired at the public school was not up to the mark, she was initially placed in Upper Kindergarten (UKG, though she was too old for UKG) to help her learn the basics, especially the English language. The teachers at Aletheia took special care to educate the child. Susheela was a boarder and as the teachers, too, were residing on the school campus, the teachers were able to dedicate extra hours for Susheela. Susheela also cooperated and put in additional effort to cope up with the pressure. Susheela could move to 5th grade in just one

year's time at Aletheia, and her performance, if not on par with fellow students, was also better than some in many aspects of study, including cultural and extracurricular activities.

Susheela's mother is grateful to the Lord and thankful to Aletheia for the transformed life of Susheela and for the knowledge that she acquired. She said that Susheela would otherwise have been working as a brick-maker. Perhaps she also would have been married by now at a very young age like her elder sister. Susheela is just one example of many that demonstrates the interest, dedication and perseverance of the Aletheia staff in identifying talented students as well as developing them into bright and intelligent ones.

### Academic performance:

The academic performance of 8th and 9th grade children is very good. Around 80% of children scored 60% and above in all of their subjects. Almost all children in these grades scored 90% and above in mathematics and science. These children are now showing extraordinary interest in mathematics and science. In the higher grades, we have very well-qualified teachers to teach mathematics and physical science. Some of the students have developed exceptionally good mathematical skills and scientific reasoning. These children have a very high potential to become state level rankers when they pass out high school public exams. This year it has been clearly observed that many children in grades 6 thru 9 realized the importance of education and now they are coming to school more regularly, more attentive in class and doing their homework more regularly.

The children of lower kindergarten, upper kindergarten, first, second and third grades did a commendable job in their studies. Due to the shortage of teachers, there were some minor shortcomings with regard to the progress of children in the fourth and fifth grade classes. We hope to get a greater number of teachers next academic year, which will improve the performance in all of all classes.

## Developing Language Skills:

The teachers at ABS understand the difficulties in the teaching-learning process due to a deficiency in language skills among the students. Though the communication skills already have improved to certain extent in the earlier years, the children require more and more practice especially in the use of tenses, sentence structure, vocabulary building, writing and speaking. Keeping this in mind, this academic year more emphasis was placed on language improvement. The children were grouped into three different levels according to their class and were drilled in these topics. Ninety-minute classes were conducted every day in English, Telugu and Hindi. We are happy to note that the children have made commendable progress in their communication skills and that these skills will improve their comprehension and further their studies.

### Games & Sports:

For the first time since the school was established, our students took part in mandal level (sub-district level) games and sports competitions in the month of November. Though they did not win at any game, they had a chance to learn the different techniques and skills of the various games. They received good exposure to competitive sports and games. Now our students have a better awareness of sports and games.

### Part III. line 28 (continued) GO GREEN:

The entire region where the school is located is a drought-stricken area with very scanty rain. All agricultural activities of the region depend upon the rains. Due to scarcity of rain, people migrate to cities to eke-out their livelihood. Migration of people is one of the major reasons for children to drop out of school. The school authorities realize the need for a plantation of trees to attract rains. Sufficient rain fall will restore agriculture and related activities and the migration of people will stop. Every year, our school procures thousands of plants and

distributes them to students to plant in their respective villages. Planting trees has been made a part of the regular curriculum and marks are given according to the number of plants planted and nurtured by the student. This year, ABS distributed more than 6,000 fruit-bearing and shade-giving varieties. The students were more than eager to carry the plants home and to nurture them carefully. Tree planting inculcates social responsibility into the student.

### Part III, line 28 (continued) Boys' Brigade India:

This year we launched BOYS' BRIGADE INDIA. Aletheia was the first to do it in India. The Boys' Brigade was founded in 1883 in Scotland and it is an international Christian organization. The objective of Boys' Brigade is the advancement of Christ's kingdom among boys and girls and the promotion of habits of obedience, reverence, discipline, self respect and all that tends towards a true Christian character. Rev. Roger from Singapore and Mr. Jason from Hong Kong visited our school and trained the students and teachers in the various aspects of Boys' Brigade drills and other activities. Student leaders and teacher-officers of Boys' Brigade were given additional training in Hyderabad. The Boys' Brigade activities will be conducted in our school on Saturdays along with character building classes. Boys' Brigade and character building classes will complement each other in building the character of the student in a Christian way. Boys' Brigade will no doubt enrich the character building syllabus. The Boys' Brigade Company of our school is the first one in India and hopefully will pioneer all Boys' Brigade activities in this country.

### Capital Improvements:

In 2015, construction progressed on new classrooms. With the help of a generous family donation of \$ 40,000, we were able to finish the brickwork of a total of eight classrooms. Another church (Lookout Mountain Presbyterian Church in

Chattanooga, TN) joined to help us finish those rooms. Even though we still need electricity, floors, doors & windows, and paint to finish these rooms, we are using the classrooms now.

A Prayer Hall was constructed at Reddinaik Thanda, Nalgonda Dist., and was dedicated to the Glory of God Almighty on March 1, 2015.

A new car was purchased this year for GBBM. Two families contributed to this need in our ministry.

### Bi-Vocational Projects:

Five Bi-Vocational projects were given to GBBM this year by an organization called On His Path from Iowa State.

HIV/AIDS Awareness Seminars and HIV Treatment:

Because of illiteracy and poverty, the people of Banjara villages are one of the most HIV/AIDS affected groups in this part of India. GBBM is using a wide range of informational strategies including awareness seminars and ongoing campaigns for all age groups to address the issue. 'Positive Patients' is one of the many popular programs bringing treatment to the Banjara people.

Agricultural-Technical Support:

One of GBBM's goals is to help Banjara farmers. GBBM continues to provide assistance by teaching modern crop management techniques and farming practices. Leadership Training:

Visitors from Nebraska and Tennessee visited during the year to conduct leadership seminars for Banjara men and women.
