### Grants That the Foundation Will Not Make

The Foundation will not make grants to international organizations or to for-profit businesses. The foundation does not typically make grants for the following purposes Requests to fund the following are likely to be denied:

- · Computers or software
- Audio or video equipment
- . Designing and producing videos
- · Recreational programs
- Dinners, balls, or other fundraising events
- Political lobbying activities, or other political purposes
- · Local, state or federal governments
- · Gifts to individuals
- Purposes outside of the Foundation's mission and funding priorities

### **Grant Duration**

Grants may be awarded for one or more years from the award date. Grant recipients are required to use the funds only for the purposes for which the grant is made during this period. Recipients will submit periodic written status reports with an accounting of funded activities, participant outcomes, and how the grant funds were used
