	Safe Houses Rapha House operates several safe houses for girls that are rescued from sex trafficking and other forms of exploitation. The safe houses provide a safe place for these girls to recover and heal through counseling, advocacy, nutrition, and education. Smiles and laughter may be the last things you would expect to encounter at a safe house for trafficked and exploited children, but these places are filled with joy. Each safe house gives girls the chance to reclaim their lost childhood. Each day the girls are treated with love and value instead of abuse and neglect. For many of these girls, this is the first time they have been treated that way. Our safe houses are staffed by local experts from the community who understand the culture and know how to work with children.

	Prevention and Education Rapha House provides education for the children as they mature in our safe house programs. Once they are ready to graduate from the safe house program, Rapha House provides emotional and vocational training so that graduates of our program remain free after leaving the safety of our centers. Additionally, Rapha House attempts to reach and educate children who have never been trafficked through our prevention programs. These prevention programs give education to children and social services to their families in order to prevent trafficking and exploitation before it ever begins.
