THESE PROCEDURES WERE FIRST SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL BY THE COMMISSIONER AS PART OF THE FOUNDATION'S EXEMPTION APPLICATION IN 2009. THE BOARD AMENDED THE PROCEDURES IN 2015 TO EXPAND THE POOL OF ELIGIBLE GRANTEEES TO INCLUDE BOTH TEACHERS AND OTHER EDUCATORS. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS WERE ALSO MADE TO THE PROCEDURES. A COPY OF THE AMENDED GRANT PROCEDURES WAS SUBMITTED TO THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE IN CINCINNATI BY CORRESPONDENCE DATED JANUARY 26, 2016.
