	to improving the quality of childcare in Stark and the surrounding counties. This is accomplished by providing training and networking opportunities as well as an extensive resource library to members. The members consist of families with
	young Children, child care staff & community agencies serving families with young children. In 2015 ECRC provided 715
	hours of professional development training and 3093 members participated in ECRC's workshops. Thirty three career
	development training (CDA) classes were provided to childcare workers who are working to attain CDA credentials & thirteen
	childcare workers completed the CDA classes. ECRC maintains a production lab that is available to all members for a
	nominal annual fee. Members can use the lab to provide educational age appropriate materials and activites for preschool
	children. In 2015, the production lab was used 2,031 times. ECRC also provides accreditation and support services for home
	day care providers who wish to obtain NAFCC or NAEYC accreditation. In 2015 ECRC offered over 500 family programs that
