Cash Distribution Test

The LaValley Foundation set aside \$100,000.00 during its fiscal year ended December 31, 2014 for funding a two year grant to Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church, Toledo, Ohio. The Foundation reported the set aside as a qualifying distribution for 2014 under the "cash distribution" test of Internal Revenue Code ("IRC") Section 4942(b)(2)(B)(ii) and, accordingly, submits this statement pursuant to Regulation Section 53.4942(a)-3(b)(7)(ii).

A. The nature and purpose of the project for which amounts are set aside: funding of a two-year grant to Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church for its church building project. The grant is to be made in increments of \$50,000 per year, beginning in 2015 and ending in 2016. A \$50,000 payment was made in 2015.

B. The amounts set aside will be paid for the specific project described in paragraph A above within 26 months after the date of the set-aside (November 4, 2014).

C. The project described in paragraph A above was not completed before December 31, 2014, the last day of the Foundation's taxable year in which the set-aside was made.

D. The distributable amounts for the Foundation, as determined under IRC 4942(d), for all past years of the Foundation since its creation are as follows:

F. The "start-up payment period" for the Foundation is January 1, 1993 through

December 31, 1996, and its "start-up period minimum amount" is: **\$900,308** (20% of \$32,579) plus (40% of \$94,675) plus (60% of \$572,211) plus (80% of \$640,744). As shown in paragraph D above, the sum of the Foundation's cash distributions during its start-up payment period was **\$2,092,000** which exceeded the start-up payment period minimum amount.

The Foundation's "full payment period" is January 1, 1997 through December 31, 2015. The "full payment minimum amount" is the sum of 100% of the distributable amount for all years in the full payment period, which is **\$17,771,710**. As shown above, the sum of the cash distributions made by the Foundation during its full payment period is **\$18,335,139** which exceeds the full payment minimum amount.
