

Where conflicting interests cannot be avoided, they must at least be disclosed and properly handled so as to minimize their impact. The document includes procedures for consistent monitoring and enforcement of compliancy when conflicts are discovered. New employees are required to complete Disclosure Forms upon hire. Employees who experience changes that could affect the answers on their Disclosure Forms are asked to request and file new. Disclosure Forms within the same year. The IHS Audit Committee has also determined that non-Board members of certain committees with decision-making roles should fill out Disclosure Forms. These committees currently include the Collections. Committee, Finance Committee, Audit Committee, Development Committee and Building Renovation Task Force.
