Ser Familia's Chair of the Financial Committee is in charge of researching comparable compensation information and present a recommendation to the Board of Directors durting the yearly discussion of the organization's budget and /or the Executive Director's job performance evaluation. It is during this time that her compensation for the next fiscal year is established. The last time that this process was done was on January 2016. The organization has a Policy for Approval of Compension for Executive Director and other Highly

Compensate Employees and Consultants that was approved on JAnuary 2011.
