

In June 2011, the Foundation increased in person program activity with the opening of its new building. More than half of the 22,000 square foot space is open to the public including a poetry library, exhibition space and performance space designed specifically for the spoken word. The Librarys 2015 activities made nearly 30,000 books of poetry and about poetry available to the public. The Foundation presented poetry programming, in person to 4,500 in its new building and several other venues. The Library and Exhibition space welcomed over 3,000 visitors on non-event days. Student and children field trips were expanded in 2015. The Foundation partnered with other cultural institutions in Chicago in order to broaden its own audience, but also provide a free resource for unique and creative public programming.
