	Minnesota. The conference featured twelve breakout sessions on topics including: Ethics of Decision Making, Home Care
	Technology, Housing Alternatives, Workforce Issues, Caregiving, and a report on the Whitehouse Conference on Aging.
	The conference attendance was 405. The annual Gerontologist of the Year award was presented, along with four scholarships awarded to higher education students

	information on evidenced-based services to seniors, to learn about relevant research that improve results, and to highlight new
	services that meet emerging and critical issues, such as elder abuse. Attendees receive continuing education credits for their
