As such, the Tomara Corporation is required to distribute one hundred percent (100%) of the funds received from the W. Thomas Kitchen Trust to satisfy the requirements imposed by Section 4942(g)(3).

Therefore, the Tomara Corporation does not have monies to invest for the long-term. The average cash balance is available until the grants are awarded and administrative expenses are paid.

Administrative expenses are greater than investment income.

The Foundation had received a \$50,000 charitable contribution from a source unrelated to the W. Thomas Kitchen Trust (a private foundation) in a prior year.

The average balance of these segregated funds in 2015 was \$48,062.
