ArtPrize Grand Rapids

The Dick and Betsy DeVos Family Foundation ("Foundation") has made a no-interest loan to ArtPrize Grand Rapids ("ArtPrize") to provide funds to assist in the organization and operations of the 2013 - 2015 ArtPrize competitions and exhibitions in Grand Rapids, Michigan in September and October.

A promissory note of \$5,000,000 was executed between the Foundation and ArtPrize in February 2013. The balance of the note on January 1, 2014 and 2015 was \$2,513,869 and \$1,557,969 respectively. In 2015, ArtPrize borrowed \$250,000 on this promissory note and was granted a partial forgiveness of the note in the amount of \$1,500,000. This amount was commensurate with the challenge grant issued by the Foundation to incentivize new and returning contributors to ArtPrize. The outstanding balance of the note as of December 31, 2015 was \$307,969.

The ArtPrize competition and exhibition is a radically open international art competition which awards the world's largest art prizes. It is considered to be part arts festival and part social experiment and creates an environment where people are inspired to go from imagining to making and doing. Its mission begins with the value that art is important. From that statement the ArtPrize competition and exhibition seeks to be a catalyst for collisions and connections between artists and communities for the sake of infusing vitality and courage into culture.
