THE FOUNDATION APPLIED FOR IRS APPROVAL OF THIS PROGRAM UNDER SECTION 4945(G)(1) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, AND RECEIVED SUCH APPROVAL ON FEBRUARY 11, 1994 APPROVAL WAS BASED ON THE FOUNDATION'S REPRESENTATION THAT IT HAD MET THE SEVEN GUIDELINES AND PERCENTAGE TEST OF REV PROC 76-47, 1976-2 C B 670 (SECTIONS 4 01 THROUGH 4 08), AND CONDITIONED UPON THE FOUNDATION'S ONGOING COMPLIANCE WITH THESE GUIDELINES
