#### Mission Statement:

#### Policy For Grant Making:

Grants will be made only to those organizations or to causes whose objectives are clearly defined. The recipient of the grant must meet the requirements of being a "qualifying distributee" for Internal Revenue purposes.

Grants will not be made to political organizations or for political purposes.

Grants will not be made to individuals.

# Ted and Grace Bachhuber Foundation, Inc.

### **Grant Application Procedure:**

The Foundation does not have a form to be filled out by a grant applicant. Any requests for grants should be made in writing specifying the purpose of the grant in particular detail.

This written request should include:

- 1. A narrative proposal describing:
  - the plan or design for the program, including activities to be carried out and objectives to be achieved.
  - the plan for continuing the project after the termination of Foundation support.
- 2. An itemized budget showing:
  - total project cost and the amount requested from the Foundation.
  - sources, amounts, and nature of resources contributed by the applicant and other supporters of the project.
- A list of any other grant-making agencies to which the application for support has been made.
- A copy of the ruling granting federal tex exemption under 501@(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
