



- (1) Contributions to charities, in the range of: \$65,000 to \$85,000 (\$65,700 in 2012, \$81,700 in 2013, \$74,850 in 2014, and \$67,100 in 2015),
- (2) Legal fees for handling investments and foundation operations, in the range of: \$50,000 to \$60,000 (\$52,881.50 in 2012, \$58,005.00 in 2013, \$53,800.00 in 2014, and \$55,000 in 2015),
- (3) IRS excise taxes, Minnesota registration filing fees, and miscellaneous expenses, in the range of: \$600 to \$1,100 (\$390.65 in 2012, \$591 in 2013, \$357.50 in 2014, and \$160.91 in 2015);
