THE OWNERS/MANAGERS CREATING OPPORTUNITY PROJECT BEGINS WITH A DATA COLLECTION PROCESS TO UNDERSTAND THE OWNER/MANAGER EXPERIENCE WITH THE HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM (BOTH PARTICIPATING AND NON-PARTICIPATING OWNERS/MANAGERS), AND WILL BE FOLLOWED BY WORK WITH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE STAKEHOLDERS TO UNDERSTAND WHAT IS CURRENTLY BEING DONE TO EXPAND LANDLORD PARTICIPATION AND WHAT GAPS MIGHT BE FILLED BY THE OWNERS AND MANAGERS CREATING OPPORTUNITY PROJECT.
