# Deadlines—April 1 / August 1

Letters of Inquiry are accepted through April 1. The Foundation Board will consider a Letter of Inquiry in June and invite proposals to be submitted by August 1 to be considered by the Board in November. Funding will be available in December for the next year.

The International Initiative provides support to programs that help women, girls, and their families overcome violence, poverty, and other hardships in under-developed countries. Priority is given to programs that:

- Address the needs of at-risk youth
- Preserve and protect the environment by using scarce resources wisely
- Address mental health (including, chemical dependency) and family planning
- Support micro-lending, providing a source of capital to create better lives

The **Children's Initiative** provides support to programs that create and promote stability and resiliency for children who have been exposed to domestic violence. Priority is given to programs that:

- Have the objective of preventing future abuse and breaking the cycle of violence
- Assist children in coping with the physical, emotional, and mental trauma of abuse
- Provide treatment and services beyond initial intervention
- Target children of middle school age and younger
- Use an approach based on proven and documented strategies and provides clear metrics to measure the program's outcomes

The Sustainable Forests and Communities Initiative supports organizations that work in forested landscapes to enhance the environment, the economy, and the community within the regions in which the Weyerhaeuser family's business originated: Idaho, Oregon, Washington, northern California, western Montana, Minnesota, and Wisconsin. Priority is given to projects that:

- Employ sustainable forest management, conservation, and ecological restoration
- Develop and encourage enterprise-based sustainable economic activities
- Use innovative social and locally-based business processes to meet agreed-upon environmental and economic sustainability goals

 Use innovative business or policy models to better establish prices and markets for ecosystem services

# **Grant Size**

- Projects whose purpose is to create specific media, film, photography, or books.
- Capital projects, including land acquisition or the construction of buildings.
- Grants or scholarships to individuals.
- Projects that attempt to change behavior by education of the general public.
- · Camps or cultural exchange programs.
- Lobbying prohibited by the Internal Revenue Code.
- Conferences.
- Endowments.
- Start-up costs or new organizations.
- Research projects.
