In addition, the plan has special safeguards in place to protect the funds from contingencies, other than insolvency. For contributions made to the plan in 2014 or after, the distribution will occur after the completion of four plan years for all executives that are still actively employed on the distribution date. Any active participant 65 years or older will receive the contribution in the current year.
