HearCare Connection provides hearing healthcare and reduced costs on hearing devices to low-income adults and under-served children. Our program is an income based program that qualifies families with a household income of up to 250% above the Federal Poverty Level. Our clinic is located in Allen County with satellite clinics in Toledo, OH and Sarasota, FL. We accept patients by appointment and serve ages birth through adult. In 2015, we had a total patient base of 547 individuals. Our community partnership includes a monthly clinic day hosted at Matthew25, partnership with the local Sertoma club, referral program through Neighborhood Health Clinic and hearing screenings at select health fairs throughout the year. We have continued our preschool screening program which provides free hearing screenings and follow up hearing tests to local preschools and daycares who have over 50% of their families on Brightpoint assistance.

In 2015, we opened up a new loaner hearing aid program for those losing their hearing to cancer treatments as well as those in hospice with hearing loss. These loaner programs are intended to help meet a critical need (the ability to hear) at a critical time (in crisis) without the constraints of income verification. The patient who qualifies for this loaner program is asked to provide volunteer hours and a small fee for accessories or earmolds. The hearing aid is provided as a loaner at no cost to the patient. With these new programs, we have partnered with Cancer Services of Northeast Indiana and Heartland Home Healthcare and Hospice.

Our program's unique approach to care includes a Circle of Giving program. This program requires volunteer hours donated back to the community for each purchase of a hearing device. Not only do our patients pay a minimal fee for services and devices, but they are also giving back to the communities who are giving to them. In

HearCare Connection, Inc. was established as an independent nonprofit 501(c) (3) organization in 2011 to provide low-income and uninsured families reduced fee hearing healthcare on a sliding scale based on income and family size. In January 2012, we began seeing patients and in June 2012 we began accepting Medicaid patients. By the end of 2012, we reached a patient base of 127 individuals. During 2013 we added another 98 new patients to our patient base. In 2013, we also began offering monthly community clinics for patients of Matthew 25. We also began working with local preschool and daycare facilities to provided hearing screenings for children. In 2014, we expanded our clinic hours to three days each week. During 2015, we served 514 individuals (295 people through our local clinic, 219 people through our community health fairs and outside clinics). We provided services through 742 appointments in our local clinic and we screened 736 preschoolers in the community. We fit 82 hearing aids in 2015.

Since our inception, we have fit over 309 hearing aids.

#### Services Provided:

Community Hearing Clinic: Hearing screenings and testing; play audiometry (testing child's hearing through play), newborn hearing tests and screenings; hearing aid services (fitting, repair and maintenance); testing for auditory processing disorder; and cochlear services. Services are provided on a reduced sliding fee scale based on household income.

Circle of Giving Model: Patients who receive a hearing aid from HearCare

Connection are required to donate volunteer hours in the community as a way of

motivating patients to invest in their own hearing care and also to promote social

connections. Volunteering in the community can help prevent feelings of isolation

and depression that often accompany hearing loss.

Community hearing aid donation program: Collection of gently used hearing aids that can be reprogrammed for low-income individuals.

Preschool/Daycare Screenings: Screenings of children on-site at local preschools and day care using our portable audiology equipment. Approximately 25% of the children screened are referred for additional testing for possible hearing loss, ear infections or other conditions.

Community Health Screenings: Hearing screenings at community health fairs, events, and other activities. 15-25% of the individuals screened at these fairs are referred for follow-up care. Off-site screenings are important in spreading awareness and make initial screenings more accessible by removing barriers of cost and transportation. We were able to participate in Focus on Health, Healthy Cities and the Community Health fair at Turnstone this past year.

Hearing Aid Loaner Program: Cancer treatments sometimes lead to hearing loss causing patients to struggle to communicate with doctors, families and support systems. We accept referrals from Cancer Services of Northeast Indiana or K21 in Warsaw and local oncologists of patients needing hearing devices. Hospice patients with hearing loss are struggling at the end of life to have significant conversations with doctors, providers and loved ones. We have partnered with Heartland Home Healthcare and Hospice to provide audiology services on site for hospice patients.

Our clinics provide hearing screenings and hearing tests; hearing aids and related apparatus; hearing aid maintenance and repairs; and follow-up care after initial treatment. We provide newborn infant screenings and Auditory Processing Disorder testing. We are able to fit individuals with gently used reprogrammable donated hearing aids collected through our community donation program. We also have the ability to purchase new hearing aids at greatly reduced costs from the manufacturer. We provide three clinic days per week. We are also supporting a monthly hearing clinic at Matthew 25. Fees for services are based on a sliding scale according to family size and income. We use this sliding scale so that hearing aids are

affordable for patients while also requiring them to make a personal investment in their own healthcare. In addition to our nominal fees, we require our patients to complete a set number of volunteer service hours at a not-for-profit agency within our community to earn "sweat equity" for their hearing aids and to help patients combat the feelings of isolation and depression that can come with hearing loss. We call this our Circle of Giving model. Because we rely on the community's support to operate our program, our patients give back to the community that has made it possible for them to receive care.
