being at least two-thirds of its members/directors legally qualified to vote in meetings of the corporation (or, in the case of a corporation having capital stock, by the holders of at least two thirds of the capital stock having the right to vote therein)

**ARTICLE I**

The exact name of the corporation is

GREENTOWN.ORG, INC.

**ARTICLE II**

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the following business activities

THE CORPORATION IS ORGANIZED AND SHALL BE OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS NOW IN EFFECT OR AS IT MAY HEREAFTER BE AMENDED, OR UNDER ANY SUCCESSOR SECTION THERETO (THE "CODE"), AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED THEREUNDER. THE PURPOSES OF THIS CORPORATION INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING: (A) TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC REGARDING CLEAN TECH, RENEWABLE ENERGY, ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND RELATED TOPICS; (B) TO RAISE FUNDS NECESSARY TO SUSTAIN THE FOREGOING ACTIVITIES AND TO EXPEND SUCH FUNDS EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE CORPORATION'S CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES; (C) TO ENGAGE IN ANY LAWFUL ACT OR ACTIVITY IN FURTHERANCE OF THE FOREGOING AND IN FURTHERANCE OF THE CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES OF THE CORPORATION AS ARE PERMITTED UNDER CHAPTER 180 OF THE MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS; AND (D) TO ENGAGE IN AND CARRY ON ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THESE PURPOSES, WHICH ARE PERMITTED TO A CORPORATION ORGANIZED UNDER CHAPTER 180 OF THE MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS, BUT ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT SUCH ACTIVITIES SHALL NOT PRECLUDE CLASSIFICATION OF THE CORPORATION AS AN ORGANIZATION EXEMPT UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE CODE.



THE FOREGOING CLAUSES SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS BOTH PURPOSES AND POWERS, AND THE ENUMERATION OF SPECIFIC POWERS THEREIN SHALL NOT BE HELD TO LIMIT OR RESTRICT IN ANY MANNER THE GENERAL POWERS OF THE CORPORATION AS ARE PERMITTED UNDER CHAPTER 180 OF THE MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS.

### ARTICLE III

A corporation may have one or more classes of members. If it does, the designation of such classes, the manner of election or appointments, the duration of membership and the qualifications and rights, including voting rights, of the members of each class, may be set forth in the by-laws of the corporation or may be set forth below.

ALL POWERS OF THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE EXERCISED ONLY IN SUCH MANNER AS WILL ASSURE THE OPERATION OF THIS CORPORATION EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES, AS DEFINED IN SECTIONS 170(C) AND 501(C) OF THE CODE, IT BEING THE INTENTION THAT THIS CORPORATION SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAXATION UNDER SECTION 501(A) OF THE CODE AS AN ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED IN SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE CODE, CONTRIBUTIONS TO WHICH ARE DEDUCTIBLE PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 170(A), 2055(A), AND 2522 OF THE CODE, AND ALL PURPOSES AND POWERS HEREIN SHALL BE INTERPRETED AND EXERCISED CONSISTENT WITH THIS INTENTION. 3. EXCEPT AS MAY BE OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY LAW, THE CORPORATION MAY AT ANY TIME, BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE DIRECTORS OF THE CORPORATION ENTITLED TO VOTE THEREON, MERGE OR CONSOLIDATE WITH OR INTO ANY CORPORATION WHICH IS ORGANIZED AND OPERATED AS AN ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED IN SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE CODE AND ORGANIZED FOR ANY ONE OR MORE OF THE PURPOSES OF THE CORPORATION AS SET FORTH IN THESE ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION, AS FROM TIME TO TIME AMENDED, OR FOR PURPOSES SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR THERETO. 4. NO PART OF THE ASSETS OR NET EARNINGS, IF ANY, OF THE CORPORATION SHALL INURE TO THE BENEFIT OF, OR BE DISTRIBUTABLE TO, ANY DIRECTOR OR OFFICER OF THE CORPORATION OR OTHER PRIVATE INDIVIDUAL, EXCEPT THAT THE CORPORATION SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO PAY REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND TO MAKE PAYMENTS AND DISTRIBUTIONS IN FURTHERANCE OF ITS PURPOSES AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE II. 
