Part III Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

28. The Nicolas Fund for Education provides safe transportation for students from their village to the school in a nearby town which is approximately 40 minutes away and back home again at the end of the day. In this town of Nebaj, these students not only attend a private junior high and high school but also receive tuition, tutoring, supplies and a nutritious meal with their scholarship. These students live in a remote agricultural region in the highlands of Guatemala where most young people do not have an opportunity to receive higher education beyond the sixth grade.

29. Each year NFE provides three opportunities for individuals, families, and especially educators to participate on Impact Teams to Guatemala. Two teams each year share enrichment activities with the NFE students and staff, as well as in two small community primary schools. These Impact Teams not only give the team members an opportunity to share their love, expertise and knowledge with the poor in the Ixil region of Guatemala but it also opens their eyes to global poverty and gives them opportunity to make a difference in the lives of the poor. The third team of the year attends the graduation of the NFE students from junior high, high school or the university. During the graduation trip the team also visits the students and their parents in their communities.

30. Major repairs were made to the primary school including replacing broken windows with reinforced security glass, a leaking roof with insulated metal roofing, refurbished the outhouse with flushing toilets, and painting the whole school including a mural designed by the kids. Provided road improvements to enable better school bus access for students travelling to secondary school outside of villages.

31. Supplied Kuske mathematics manipulative blocks to two village primary schools to help teachers explain fractions and other math principles. Science supplies were also provided (magnifying glasses, prisms, small microscopes) in addition to new projectors for teachers.
