The mission of the SafetyLit Foundation is to provide a comprehensive, easy-to-use, searchable, Internet-based bibliographic database of scholarly journal articles, technical reports, and theses concerning all issues of safety arising from many professional disciplines and nations. The items will be indexed in a way that access to information by policy-makers, practitioners, researchers, and the general public will not be hindered by obscure professional jargon or arcane search terms.

**Form 990-EZ, Part III, Line 28: Program Service Accomplishments**

SafetyLit provides <sup>TWO</sup> interconnected services: 1) a weekly Update Bulletin (ISSN 1556- 8849) that includes about 400 recently-published items from more than 14000 scholarly journals of the many professional disciplines that do work that is relevant to preventing unintentional injuries (accidents), interpersonal violence, and self-harm. (Last fiscal year the Update Bulletin contained about 300 items each week.)

This weekly Update is sent by email to 8400 subscribers (up from 7200 last fiscal year). The update is also available by 38 RSS feeds one for each of the 37 categories by which items are assigned plus one feed that includes all items. 2) a database of scholarly publications beginning with items released in the mid 17th century about the safety of farmers, mariners, and miners. The 400+ items that appear in each Weekly Update Bulletin are automatically added to the database as are about 200 additional items identified through examination of scholarly journal back issues. At the end of the 2015 fiscal year the database contained 490 thousand items. The SafetyLit site received an average of 22,000 unique visitors each month during FY 2015 a majority of whom used the SafetyLit system multiple times.

Per the Alexa and Majestic monitors, during FY 2015 the number of links to SafetyLit from government agencies and libraries increased from about 250 to about 300.
