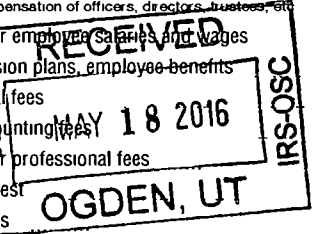

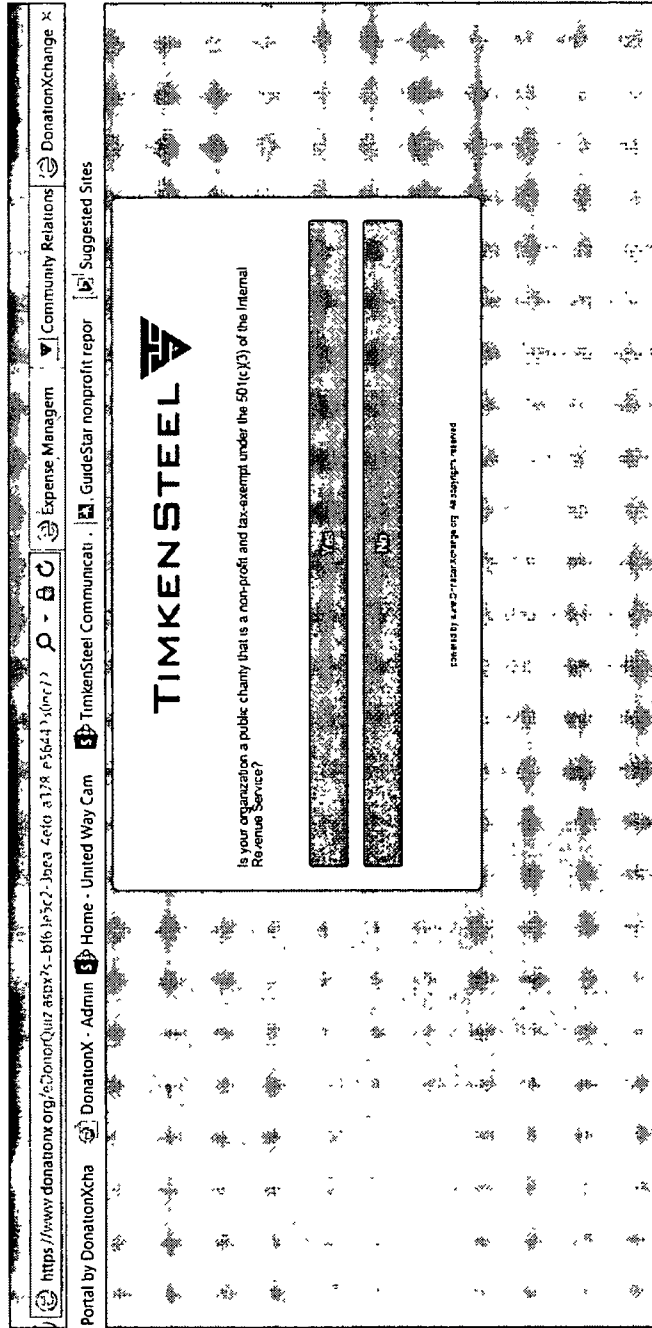

## TimkenSteel Charitable Fund Grant Guidelines

The purpose of the TimkenSteel Charitable Fund (the “Fund”) is to improve through charitable giving the quality of life in the communities where TimkenSteel associates live and work. The following are general guidelines for grant applicants seeking grants from the Fund:

- The Fund makes grants to 501(c) (3) public charities (described in Sections 509(a)(1) or (a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code) that support charitable programs in our focus areas in the United States. The Fund does not make grants to organizations operating outside the United States.
- Grants are made primarily to charities serving our local plant communities (currently Akron, Canton and St. Clair, Ohio, Tryon Peak, South Carolina and Houston, Texas).
- Our primary focus areas include support for programs in the arts, education and community and economic development. The Fund does not provide support or make grants to or for the following:
  - Capital campaigns and projects
  - Political activities/programs
  - Religious activities/programs
  - Individuals in need
  - Organizations other than public charities described in Sections 509(a)(1) or (a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code
  - Organizations organized and operated outside the United States
- We will consider a limited number of requests from community basic needs organizations; however, our primary support for this focus area is through contributions to United Way.
- Preference is given to organizations that provide the broadest community outcomes aligned with our focus areas and that engage TimkenSteel Corporation associates as volunteers.
- Grant submissions are reviewed and approved by the Board of Trustees of the Fund. Consideration of a grant request and the approval or denial of grant requests is in the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees, acting in furtherance of the Fund’s charitable mission. Approval of a grant in one year does not guarantee approval of a similar grant request in a subsequent year.

## TimkenSteel Charitable Fund Matching Gift Program Guidelines



In furtherance of its charitable purposes, the TimkenSteel Charitable Fund (the "Fund") encourages and supports the generosity and community involvement of TimkenSteel employees ("associates") through the TimkenSteel Charitable Fund Matching Gift Program, which provides matching grants to approved charitable organizations that associates support through their own individual charitable giving. This program furthers the Fund's charitable mission to charitable organizations within the community, while giving associates the opportunity to increase the impact of their contribution

### Who Can Participate

- All active U.S. employees and directors of TimkenSteel Corporation and its wholly-owned U.S. subsidiaries.
- **Ineligible Donors:** Retired employees, contingent workers and relatives of employees

### Contribution Limits

- The TimkenSteel Charitable Fund matching gift program has a quarterly cap (maximum amount that can be granted) which is determined annually by the TimkenSteel Charitable Fund Board of Trustees.
- The individual minimum association donation is \$20.
- The individual associate cap is \$500 per year.

### Gift Eligibility Rules

- Minimum charitable gift to be matched per charitable organization is \$20, with an aggregate maximum gift match of \$500 per associate per year. The TimkenSteel Charitable Fund may at any time, in its direction, reduce the maximum matching gift amount to any particular charitable organization based on the total number of matching gift and grant requests for that organization.
- Only the tax-deductible portion of an associate's charitable gift will be matched
- Gifts may be made via cash, check, credit card or stock (with an established market value for stock determined by the average of the high/low price on the day the gift is made).
- Gifts must be personal contributions actually made, not pledged.
- Gifts to be matched must be made by an individual. Gifts made collectively by a group are not eligible.
- Tuition and dues to educational institutions, even if such institutions are otherwise approved, are not eligible.
- Gifts that benefit the associate or any member of an associate's family cannot be matched.
- Matching gifts cannot be made in satisfaction of any individual's binding charitable pledge.

### Eligible Recipient Organizations

- Eligible recipient organizations for this program are United States tax-exempt public charities described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, are also described in Section 509(a)(1) or (a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code and that have been approved by the Fund upon verification. *(Note: The TimkenSteel Charitable Fund does not match associate gifts to United Way; such contributions are subject to a separate type of match and are excluded from this program.)*

### Ineligible Recipient Organizations

- Political or religious organizations.
- Organizations organized and operated outside of the United States.
- Organizations that are not public charities described in Sections 509(a)(1) or (a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (e.g., private foundations and supporting organizations.)

### How the Program Works

The associate should:

- Go to [www.timkensteel.com/matchinggifts](http://www.timkensteel.com/matchinggifts) to follow the steps to request a matching gift on the online associate giving portal.

Eligible gifts will be processed monthly.

Matching gift requests must be received within 6 months of the gift date. Requests received after that time will not be matched.

### Other General Rules

The TimkenSteel Charitable Fund reserves the right, in its sole discretion, not to match any particular gift to any organization, and to determine which organizations are eligible recipient organizations for the purposes of this Program. The TimkenSteel Charitable Fund also reserves the right to limit the amount of money it will contribute to the matching gift program in any calendar year; to amend or terminate this program at any time and to make such interpretation in the administration of this program as may be required.
