

As a result of the analysis, it was determined that \$150,848 would possibly have qualified as charity care. There is a fine line between bad debt and charity care. There are those individuals who just will not pay, but there are a larger number of individuals who cannot pay, but do not want to fill out the paperwork for charity care or do not want to even ask for charity care. We have estimated that \$150,848 of our bad debt expense should have been classified as charity care if the appropriate paperwork was received. These are the dollars that should be classified as community benefit.

These services are integral to the community and would not be available to the community if they were not provided by our facility.

Also, our board members and employees who are in the public advise us as to what health care needs are in the community that we do not currently address. This is a program that is good for our patients even though we receive little to no reimbursement for providing this service. We provide free sport screens to area athletes who have been injured at a practice or game. We hosted a health fair to reach out to those who do not regularly schedule a clinic visit or annual lab tests.


