An evaluation form is sent annually to all board members for their ratings and comments. Spot interviews are also randomly conducted with current staff, donors, prospective donors, and other key constituents, in addition to factoring in the results of an annual cultural health survey. Once all of the information has been compiled, the President & CEO meets with the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Chairman of the Governance Committee to discuss the results. The compensation committee then meets to discuss salary recommendations based on an analysis conducted by an independent HR consultant and some scan of data from the local market. The Committee formulates a compensation recommendation and brings it forward to the Board of Directors to discuss, review, and approve in Executive Session with minutes taken.

Officers & key employees meet with their supervisors on a formal basis bi-annually to discuss performance. Less formal meetings are held at least monthly. Based on performance and market data provided by an independent consultant, supervisors recommend market and merit-based salary adjustments, they are reviewed by the President and CEO in conjunction with the budget, adjusted and/or approved as recommended, and subsequently granted.
