FEDERATED CHURCH FOUNDATION APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL (2015-2016)

APPLICATION CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

I. Terms for the Renewal of the Scholarship

- A. Students must enroll at least ½ time status.
- B. Students must pass 75% of the credits for which they register each term.
- C. Scholarship funds must be used for educational costs.
- D. Students are able to select their program of study.
- E. Scholarship amount may vary depending upon circumstances including college attending.
- F. Scholarship is renewable until completion of an undergraduate degree, not to exceed five (5) annual awards.

II. Criteria for Selection

- A. Scholarships will be awarded to graduating students from Columbus, Nebraska, Area Schools.
- B. The applicant is a member of the Federated Church of Columbus, Nebraska;
- C. The applicant's mother, father or legal guardian is a member of the Federated Church of Columbus, Nebraska; or
- D. Although the applicant is not a member of Federated Church of Columbus, Nebraska, nor his mother, father or legal guardian, such applicant may petition the Foundation Board of Directors to consider the applicant's substantial active participation in Federated Church activities as qualifying them for a scholarship.
- E. Added consideration may be given to students enrolling at Hastings College or Doane College.

III. Other Factors Concerning the Award

- A. This scholarship plan may be changed from year to year by the Federated Foundation Board. However, such changes cannot affect any award already made.
- B. All applicants agree that the decisions of the Federated Foundation Board in the granting of awards, making of payments under the same, and interpretations of these rules shall be final and binding upon them.
- C. Scholarship awards will be announced no later than July 23, 2015.
- D. As extenuating circumstances may warrant, the Federated Foundation Board may make special consideration of issues relating to continuation or revocation of the scholarship.
- E. A scholarship check will be mailed to the scholarship recipient which is payable to the recipient and the educational institution. Should an educational institution not be able to process that check, a second check will be prepared which will be payable only to the scholarship recipient when the recipient is enrolled at the educational institution and the first check is returned.

- 3. Attach your most recent <u>Transcript</u> from your educational institution to the application, through and including the second semester of the current academic year. (Photocopy is acceptable.) Please make sure to include all credit hours taken during the pursuit of your undergraduate degree.
- 4. Scholarship renewal application (complete with attachments) should be sent or delivered to the Scholarship Committee at the address below to be <u>received or postmarked no later than June 26, 2015</u>. Applications will be accepted at the Federated Church Office only.
