Page 1, Question J, Accounting Method Explanation

Thrive Foundation for Youth Inc will use a modified accrual method to report revenue and expenses for tax purposes. All items of taxable income are to be reported in accordance with the tax reporting documents received by Thrive Foundation for Youth Inc (e.g., Forms 1099 & Schedules K-1). In general, deductions for expenses are to be reported on a cash basis in the year paid. However, if expenses with respect to services are paid in the year following the year the services were provided, these expenses are to be accrued and reported in the year the services were received. Also, if costs are paid for items that have more than one year's benefit (e.g., insurance premiums) then these amounts are to be capitalized and amortized over the period of service or coverage. Prepaid expenses are recorded as assets on the balance sheet.
