There are no detailed guidelines for applications to the Four Lanes Trust. All that is required, in whatever form you elect to send it, is a brief outline, in writing, of your program, your budget, your financial requirements and other sources of support for your overall program, and of the number of people serviced by your program. The Trust will not normally make grants solely on the basis of form letters of request. It encourages applicants to use the proposal form approved by the Washington Regional Association of Grantmakers if they have already used this form for applications to other prospective funders.

In evaluating grant requests, the Trustees pay particular attention to:

- Organizations that for one reason or another are in special need of funds for a finite period of time. Such reasons might be the process of start-up of a new organization or a transitional period between the lapse of a traditional funding source and the development of new sources of more permanent funding.
- Organizations to which a grant that the Trust is able to make – typically of \$500 - \$2,000 – can make a real difference.
- Organizations that cater to the needs of the disadvantaged, especially those that make possible access to the performing or decorative arts that would not otherwise be available.
- The relationship between program-related expenditures and general and administrative expenses.

Applications from organizations in the District of Columbia will be given special consideration.

Although the Trust is able to make grants at any time, it typically considers applications that are of no particular urgency towards the end of the calendar year.
